CASA

CASA (Coimbra Architecture Summer Atelier) is an intensive eleven-day workshop organized by the Department of Architecture of the University of Coimbra, Portugal. It consists mainly of design workshops where participants, guided by Ateliers Tutors, can develop proposals that respond to the themes presented; and in conferences and debates where concepts, ideas and projects are conferred in order to strengthen the strategies to be developed.

CASA's mission is to combine practical and theoretical modules, focusing on several problems of the Coimbra's territory, aiming to work the built environment from its social, architectural and urban context. CASA created a protocol in order to improve the connections between the summer school and (inter)national Universities / Institutions / Schools.

NETWORK

CASA Network is a national and international protocol created by the organization team in association with the Department of Architecture of the University of Coimbra. The network's purpose is to establish partnerships between CASA and other teaching institutions on a worldwide spectrum, providing the opportunity for knowledge transfer between Architecture, Art, Design and Urbanism schools and promoting a rich and multicultural learning environment through student and teaching staff exchange.
