About the Residence

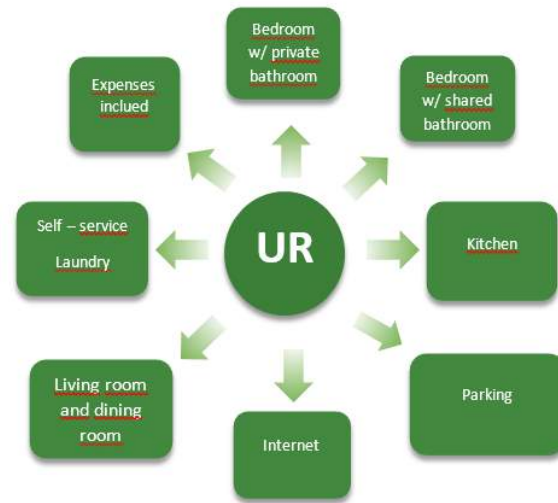
The residence has three floors, double and single bedrooms, 6 with private bathroom and 5 with shared bathroom. The residence has a kitchen and living room in the basement.

Amenities

Internet

Internet access within the common areas of the residence, after requesting the password at the Faculty in which you are enrolled.

Internal Functioning

Admission/Exit



The access to the residence and rooms is made through the student card and must be activated in accommodation office.

The resident must fill out the admission form and the Portuguese Immigration and Borders Service form (if you are not a Portuguese citizen).

Upon check-out, you must return the temporary card to the residential assistant and fill out the exit form. The admission and exit forms are signed and dated by both parties.

Exchange of the bed and bathroom linen

The distribution of fresh linen and the exchange of used linen is made weekly on Monday and Tuesdays, during the work schedule: from 9:30 am to 12:30 am and from 1:30 pm to 4:30 pm.



Clothes maintenance

The residence has a self-service laundry located in the basement with payment by student card. This laundry treatment area has washing, drying machine, iron and ironboard.

Kitchen

The cooling appliances and cabinets available are meant for all residents, who must agree on space assignment in common storage areas.

There's a closed cupboard in the kitchen for every resident.



Cleaning

SASUC guarantee thorough cleaning of all areas every week.

The residents must keep all areas clean on a daily basis, including the bedrooms, as well as keep the room clean and tidy.



Distribution of toilet paper

The residential assistant distributes per resident monthly 2 toilet paper rolls and detergent for cleaning the kitchen stands.

Personal belongings safety

There are closed closets in every bedroom for residents to store their personal belongings. Whenever personal belonging storage is required elsewhere, you must ask SASUC for permission.



Mail

Personal mail is received by the residential assistant or the delegate student, who will leave it in your bedroom (package or registered mail) or at the entrance table.
